Dear Catherine:

Indian Creek Township does not intend to enter into the contract with the Indian Creek Fire Fighters Association, Inc., which you proposed through your fax of April 15, 2007.

As you know, May 9, 2007 is the last day of service of the Indian Creek Fire Fighters, Inc. (the Corporation) under their contract with Indian Creek Township. As of 12:01 a.m. on May 10, 2007, the Corporation will cease to provide fire protection for Indian Creek Township's governmental properties, for the fire station and for the populace of Indian Creek.

Indian Creek Township has entered into a contract for emergency services with Van Buren Township, which will provide emergency protection for Indian Creek Township by full time coverage by two firefighters at Van Buran Station 19. Indian Creek Township is entering into mutual aid agreements with all surrounding fire departments for emergency services. Indian Creek Township is notifying Mr. Jeff Schemmer, Communications Director of Monroe County Central Emergency Dispatch system that the contract with the Corporation is ending, and that as of May 10, 2007, all 911 calls from Indian Creek Township will be dispatched to Van Buren Township, not to the Corporation.

It is my understanding that as of May 10, 2007 Corporation members without affiliation with an authorized emergency department will not be authorized to respond to emergencies, and that the Corporation's vehicles will not be legally authorized emergency vehicles.

Under these circumstances, and on behalf on Indian Creek Township of Monroe County, Indiana, I hereby give Indian Creek Fire Fighters, Inc. notice to quit the Indian Creek fire station

premises on or before midnight at the end of May 9,2007. As of that time, the Corporation will cease to provide fire protection in Indian Creek Township, which is a part of the consideration for the lease.

Again, on behalf of the Indian Creek Township Trustee, I state the Township's willingness to purchase all of the Corporation's equipment for \$1.00, and to accept responsibility for any liens secured by that equipment.

On behalf of the Indian Creek Township Trustee, I request that by April 26, 2007 the Corporation advise the Township of its intentions with respect to turning over the fire station and selling the equipment to the Township. Our opportunity to plan and provide for a smooth transition will enhance the safety of Indian Creek Township Residents. It will also allow us to integrate Corporation affiliated volunteer fire fighters who are interested in volunteering with the new Indian Creek Township Fire Department into that department, which will be operated directly through the Township.

Finally, on behalf of the Indian Creek Township Trustee, I express deep appreciation for the many years of service provided by Indian Creek Fire Fighters, Inc. to the Township.
