Re: Indian Creek Township Emergency Services


Dear Mr. Schemmer:


For many years, Indian Creek Township has carried out its statutory duty to provide fire and emergency protection through the Indian Creek Fire Fighters Association, Inc., which is an independent nonprofit corporation. For a variety of reasons, Indian Creek Township has decided to terminate that relationship. The contract expires on May 9, 2007.

Indian Creek Fire Fighters Association, Inc. will cease to be the provider of emergency services for Indian Creek Township of Monroe County as of midnight at the end of May 9, 2007. Indian Creek Township is entering into a contract with Van Buren Township to provide primary coverage, through its station 19, which is located very close to the northern edge of Indian Creek Township. Indian Creek Township is entering into mutual aid contracts with all adjoining fire departments.

As of midnight at the end of May 9, 2007, please dispatch Indian Creek Township emergency calls through Van Buren Township. As of that time, no further Indian Creek Township emergency calls should be sent to Indian Creek Fire Fighters Association, Inc.
