Dear Catherine:

Thank you for providing the documentation that I requested concerning the staff and equipment of Indian Creek Fire Fighters, Inc. I have reviewed it with Indian Creek Township Trustee Linda Hollingsworth, and we have found it to be satisfactory.

Enclosed you will find an Indian Creek Township check in the sum of \$7,875 .00, to be credited toward paid firefighters, firefighting and emergency services for the 90 day contract extension period from January 15, 2007 through April 14, 2007, with respect to the March 16,2006 contract for Fire Protection.


In your letter of February 27, 2007, you conclude that the quarterly payment is to be \$13,875. That would be an annual rate of \$55,500 per year, with a per diem of \$152. I calculate the contract period as running from January 15, 2007 through 90 days from the termination of contract notice date, which was February 9, 2007, for a total of 115 days. That final termination of the contract is May 10, 2007. The total payment for the 115 days from January 15, 2007 through May 10, 2007 is \$17,480. The Township has already paid \$6,000 for that period, and is now paying another \$7,875. This leaves a balance of \$3,605 payable on the contract. Assuming services are still being provided as contracted, that payment will be made on April 15, 2007. That will be the final payment under the current extended contract

This payment and the expected April 15 payment of \$3,605 are made with full reservation of rights, especially with respect to Paragraph 11 of the contract. While the documentation provided gives us confidence that the Corporation's equipment and other contractual

requirements are now being met, it also adds to our concern that those requirements were not met during prior periods for which payment was made. However, it is certainly our hope that no determination of such matters will ever need to be made, and that the Indian Creek Fire Fighters. Inc. and Indian Creek Township will terminate their relationship without conflict, on May 10, 2007.

Thank you for your continuing assistance with this matter.
